The Claretian congregation was founded by St. Antony Mary Claret in spain in the year 1849. At present there are over 3000 claretian fathers working in 74 countries of the world.

Over 600 Claretian fathers are working in 14 states, in India. They serve the floor and marginalized through pastoral and spiritual animation, educational endeavours, care for the leprosy affected patients ex-prisoners, the blind, the differently abled, tribalsand Dalits. In India they run more than 35 educational institutions and dozens of village educational institutions in the remote parts of the country.

The students and staff have collected 1 lakh 53 thousand rupees for the Sneha foundation for the rehabilitation of blind, Vijayawada students also collected around 50 thousands rupees for the persons suffering from serious health problems. On 20<sup>th</sup> September 2024, we contributed 80,000 rupees for the rehabilitation of the blind from Karimnagar. A relief fund of 2000 rupees was given to the victims of flood in Wayanad on 14<sup>th</sup> November, on the occasion of childrens day.
